

Week 5 - Division Facts

Fluency 1 - Match the division number sentence to the multiplication number sentence that tells them the answer.

One has been done for you.

$15 \div 5 = 3$	$2 \times 10 = 20$
$60 \div 10 = 6$	$5 \times 3 = 15$
$20 \div 2 = 10$	$6 \times 10 = 60$
$16 \div 2 = 8$	$5 \times 9 = 45$
$45 \div 5 = 9$	$2 \times 8 = 16$

Fluency 2

$14 \div 2 = \boxed{7}$

$90 \div 10 = \boxed{9}$

$30 \div 5 = \boxed{6}$

$20 \div 5 = \boxed{4}$

$70 \div 10 = \boxed{7}$

$18 \div 2 = \boxed{6}$

Fluency 3

$20 \div \boxed{5} = 4$

$40 \div \boxed{8} = 5$

$\boxed{20} \div 2 = 10$

$\boxed{80} \div 10 = 8$

$50 \div 5 = \boxed{10}$

$30 \div \boxed{6} = 5$
