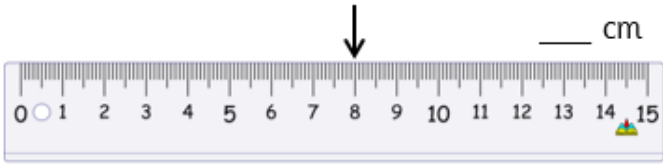
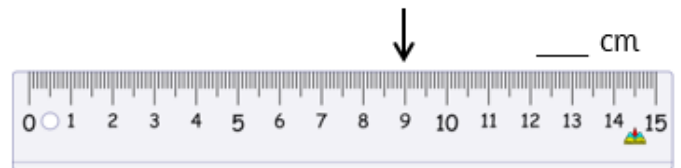


Layer 1 - How many cm does the arrow show?
